- Formally submit train paths to Network Rail in accordance with track access conditions.
- Suitably liaise with Operations planning and DRS control.
- Proactively identify future engineering proposals that affect DRS services.
- Check through Confirmed Period Possession Plans and identify all services affected by engineering work.
- Retime affected trains using VoyagerPlan and compile specification detailing amendments using Word.
- Submit bids to Network Rail teams containing Word documents and Voyager Plan electronic files. Upon receipt of offer from Network Rail, update Voyager Plan with finalised timings.
- Use VoyagerPlan to create Weekly Amendments Notice and distribute internally.
- Any other duties as required by the needs of the business.
